

HOW TO REGISTER

- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration deadline for July Camps is **June 1, 2012**. Registration deadline for August Camps is **July 1, 2012**. Payment in full is required.
- For all camps, a health form must be completed and on file before the start of camp. A standard doctor's form is acceptable. Camp forms are downloadable from the payment page.
- Activities are subject to change.
- Registration for all camps is done on our website. We accept MasterCard, Visa, Discover, and American Express.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

If cancellation occurs two weeks before the start of the camp, the fee, less 25%, will be refunded. Refunds are not available after that date.
