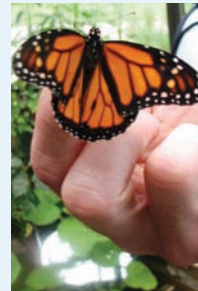
#### Critters, Crafts & Kids
