GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

- The Center has a staff of professional educators who gear each program to the grade level of your students. We will accommodate any competency or physical needs level if notified in advance. Our programs stress hands-on and direct-involvement learning. We strive to meet the needs of educators and follow the requirements of the New York State Syllabus, such as utilizing measurement tools and developing critical thinking skills.
- Outreach Programs for grades pre-K–2 may be scheduled for 60, 90 or 120 minutes, divided into half-hour segments. Programs for grades 3-12 may only be scheduled for 90 minutes, divided into 45-minute segments.



- In-House Programs for grades pre-K-2 are one hour in length. Programs for grades 3-12 are 90 minutes. A maximum of three classes may be scheduled at the same time. All programs are presented rain or shine. A portion of each class is presented out of doors, so children should dress appropriately.
- In-House Extended Day Programs are available for grades 1-12. For grades 1-2, this set of two programs begins at 10:30 a.m. and includes one 60-minute "seasonal" program, such as Aquatic Adventure or Apple Cidering and one 60-minute Animal Adventure program, with a one-hour lunch break in the middle. The day ends at approximately 1:30 p.m. For grades 3-12, this set of two programs begins at 10:00 a.m. and includes one 90-minute "seasonal" program, such as Pond Ecology or Apple Cidering and one 90-minute Animal Adaptations program, with a one-hour lunch break in the middle. The day ends at approximately 2:00 p.m. Call for details.
- Customized Programs are available for grades K-12 and may include Reptiles & Amphibians, Rocks & Soils, Endangered Species, and Turtles of Westchester. One month minimum notice is required.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Picnicking is allowed by school groups only by prior arrangement. Groups must bring their own trash bags and clean up before leaving.
- Collecting of plants and animals is strictly prohibited.
- Our gift shop has many low priced items that are related to our programs.

PROGRAM FEES

In-House: Maximum class size 25 students

A maximum of three classes may be scheduled at the same time. Your group will be met by a naturalist in the visitor's parking lot.

Grades pre-K-2

60-minute program is \$125.00 per naturalist

Grades 3-12

90-minute program is \$175.00 per naturalist

Extended Day-Grades 1-2

Set of two 60-minute programs is \$250.00 per naturalist

Extended Day-Grades 3-12

Set of two 90-minute programs is \$350.00 per naturalist
